- ← The purpose of the *Bob Piper Construction Education Scholarship* is to encourage further education and support growth in the construction industry.

Areas of Interest:

- ← Construction-related fields or professions including, but not limited to, electrical, plumbing, HVAC, masonry, painting, carpentry, architecture, or construction management.

Award Categories/Level of Education:

- ← A maximum of four scholarships (2-\$1000 & 2-\$500) will be awarded this year.
- ← Scholarships are available to students pursuing a Certificate of Completion or a post-secondary education leading to a Bachelor's Degree in a **construction-related field**.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ← Intend to register at or attending an accredited college/university or post-secondary vocational school of his/her choice.
- ← Complete the scholarship application.
- ← Provide high school or post-secondary vocational school transcript.
- ← Have a minimum accumulative grade point average of 2.0 from high school or post-secondary vocational school.
- ← Provide two (2) letters of recommendation. (The people providing the recommendations must include a phone number where they can be reached for verification).
- ← Be an American citizen or naturalized citizen.

Payment:

- ← Scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university or post-secondary vocational school with proof of registration from the participating educational institution. Payments will only be made toward tuition, books, room and board, and course related materials/supplies.
