Purpose:

- ✦ The purpose of the *Bob Piper Construction Education Scholarship* is to encourage further education and support growth in the construction industry.

Areas of Interest:

- ✦ Construction-related fields or professions including, but not limited to, electrical, plumbing, HVAC, masonry, painting, carpentry, architecture, or construction management.

Award Categories/Level of Education:

- ✦ A maximum of four scholarships (2-\$1000 & 2-\$500) will be awarded this year.
- ✦ Scholarships are available to students pursuing a Certificate of Completion or a post-secondary education leading to a Bachelor's Degree in a **construction-related field**.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ✦ Intend to register at or attending an accredited college/university or post-secondary vocational school of his/her choice.
- ✦ Complete the scholarship application.
- ✦ Provide high school transcript.
- ✦ Have a minimum accumulative grade point average of 2.0 from high school.
- ✦ Provide two (2) letters of recommendation. (The people providing the recommendations must include a phone number where they can be reached for verification).
- ✦ Be an American citizen or naturalized citizen.
- ✦ Must currently attend a high school in the state of Colorado.

Payment:

- ✦ Scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university or post-secondary vocational school with proof of registration from the participating educational institution. Payments will only be made toward tuition, books, room and board, and course related materials/supplies.
